Afterschool Program (A+) registration will begin on **Monday, April 14, 2025 at 4:00 pm**. Applications will be date and time stamped in the order received. You may also apply online after registration starts, but please note, there were some glitches last year with the State Office not getting the online application to our site until much later. We would like to encourage you to register as soon as possible so we can verify employment (please make sure you have employer contact information) and, if needed, income. Our goal is to start A+ on the first day of school. We need to have 20 students with completed applications (with employment, and if applied for, income verified) and payment received prior to the first day of school. (Note: Payment collection will begin July 1st, however, are not due to the first day of school.)

Because of the nature of staffing, there is always some uncertainty, the following factors affect when we can start and the numbers we can accept.

- Minimum 20 students with completed, verified, and paid applications; and
- Minimum of 2 staff available each day (that are approved by DHS) to start.
- We would not be able to go over 40 students, until we have a minimum of 3 staff available each day (that are approved by DHS). We will keep a waiting list until we can establish adequate staffing.

The application as well as a subsidy application are attached. Forms can also be picked up at A+ or in the front office. The parent handbook (digital only) and printable forms are available online at the State A+ Website https://hawaiicommunityengagement.com/after-school-plus/resources/

The current A+ tuition rate for SY 2025-2026 is \$200 per month. Families who participate in the A+ Program may qualify for financial assistance through the Department of Human Services (DHS). To qualify, families must meet income eligibility requirements. DHS provides the A+ Programs with an Income Eligibility Table to assist families with qualifying for subsidies. For SY 2025-2026, the gross income limit for DHS A+ Program subsidies to 300% of the 2024 Federal Poverty Level for Hawai'i. The Income Eligibility Table will be shared with families via the A+ website at the above website.
