Dear Families of the Waialua Complex,

We hope that you and your loved ones continue to remain safe as our community recovers from the recent flooding.

Due to the impacts of flooding, classrooms across our campuses require additional professional cleaning, testing, and safety clearance. This process is necessary to ensure that all learning spaces are safe and ready for students and staff to return.

As a result, Hale'iwa Elementary, Waialua Elementary, and Waialua High & Intermediate will be closed to students on Tuesday, March 24, and Wednesday, March 25. There will be no in-person instruction on these days, and students should not report to campus.

Thursday, March 26, is a state-observed holiday.

At this time, school is planned to resume on Friday, March 27, pending final safety clearance of all facilities.

The safety and well-being of our students and staff remain our top priority. We will only reopen once all classrooms and campus areas have been fully cleared and deemed safe for use.

To support our school communities during this time:

- Each school will have a water buffalo tank available daily from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. while campuses are closed.
- Community members are welcome to come to campus during these hours to access water.

Once school resumes:

- Water buffalo access will continue to be available to the community from 2:30–4 p.m.

We understand that this situation continues to present challenges for many of our families, and we sincerely appreciate your patience, understanding, and resilience.

We will continue to keep you informed with any updates as they become available.
