Here are a few examples of ways that I can assist and work with your school team:

- Assist with family support (eg: work with the school team to identify family needs and refer them to the resources/agencies based on needs- community resources, such as: medical, social services, financial assistance, etc.)
 - Address attendance issues (eg: attend parent/guardian attendance meetings and plans, assist in identifying barriers to coming to school and provide support to work through those barriers, follow-up phone calls/meetings with parents, as needed etc)
 - Available to conduct home visits alongside school personnel as families may have questions about school-related matters
 - Provide consultation services (eg: link to community resources, social service agencies, etc)
 - Participate in School Team Meetings (eg: monthly peer reviews, student specific peer reviews, SFT's, IEP's, 504's as needed)
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Helpful Attendance Information

- Clearly communicate your school's attendance policy to parents/guardians and students
- Involve your HSP early in the process when there is a pattern of student absences by scheduling a Peer Review meeting and inviting your HSP
- Continue to document all interventions and contact regarding student (Tier 1-3 interventions)
- Celebrate successes (even small ones!) to build meaningful relationships with student/family
